## REGISTRATION PROCESS FOR THE HEALTH SCIENCE PROGRAM

There is a process for students to become eligible and registered for the Health Science Program, and the first step begins with:

1. Participating in a Health Science Program Orientation.
2. After that, students will register for the TABE assessment, a basic skills test in Reading, Math, and Language. There is a \$15.00 fee to schedule a date to take the TABE; scheduling is done in the Registration Office. In order to begin this process, students must complete a "Verification of Florida Student Identification Number" form that is included in the Orientation packet. Students then meet with staff member in the Office of Admissions to verify the information. (Pursuant to State Board Rule 6A-10.040(8), the TABE assessment can be exempted if a student meets one of the following criteria and can provide official documentation: (1) Has an Associate's or (2) Bachelor's Degree from accrediting agency approved by Broward County Schools, or (3) Graduated from a Florida Public High School with a standard High School Diploma after the year 2007.
3. After students take the TABE assessment, they will meet with a Counselor/Advisor to receive their TABE results. (PN students also need to register for the Test of Essential Academic Skills or "TEAS ". There is a \$60.00 fee to schedule a date to take the TEAS; scheduling is done in the Registration Office.
4. When students meet eligibility, the Counselor/Advisor will explain the registration process to the students.
5. In addition to passing the TABE/TEAS, students will also need to pass a Level 2 background check and a drug screening, have a current physical examination, and satisfy the immunization requirements (approved vendor only).

**IMPORTANT! HEALTH SCIENCE TECHNOLOGY PROGRAMS:** (International students must first come to the U.S. on a visitor's visa to fulfill all admissions requirements for these programs. After all requirements are met and the students have been accepted into these programs, the Form I-20 can then be processed and International students will be eligible to apply for the M-1 student visa.
