To Schedule Your Test:

- Go to ATC's main campus, Building 10, Office of Student Affairs, to complete registration paperwork.
 - The TABE is free to high school students.
 - For your initial testing, you may be required to schedule 2 sessions.
 - Space in a testing session must be reserved at least 24 hours in advance.
- Once registration paperwork is completed, your test can be scheduled by one of ATC's Registrars.
 - There are no tests given on school holidays. Times listed are test start times.
- Be sure to arrive 10 minutes early and bring your current official picture I.D. (HS picture ID is OK) and registration paperwork.
- High school students with an IEP or 504 Plan may utilize classroom/testing accommodations for the TABE.
