#### Program Length/Schedule:

2400 hours/approx. 24 months (full -time)

#### **Admission Requirements:**

- 18 Years of Age or older by October of entering year
- · High School or High School Equivalency Diploma
- Complete a Program Orientation
- · Basic Skills Testing or Exemption
- · Meet with Program Counselor/Advisor

#### Job Outlook in the Ft. Lauderdale area:

- Demand for Automotive Technicians is expected to grow about 6% between 2016 and 2026 (Source: Bureau of Labor Statistics).
- Entry level wages for Toyota Technicians are about \$14/hour (Source: The Florida Department of Economic Opportunity). Actual wages vary according to education, experience and certifications.

T-TEN students must take ASE Certification exams during their time in the program and pass a minimum of two (2) ASE areas prior to completing the T-TEN Program.

#### **Course Content:**

The Advanced Automotive Service Technology (Toyota T-TEN) program is specific to Toyota/Lexus products using Toyota/Lexus automotive vehicles, trainers, parts, tools and curriculum materials. Instruction includes practical classroom applications and an internship experience at a Toyota/Lexus dealership under the supervision of a Certified Toyota/Lexus Technician and the Program Teacher-Coordinator. Instruction also coincides with the eight (8) areas of professional technician certification recognized by the ASE Education Foundation. Today's technicians must possess advanced skills in math, communications, electronics and the ability to diagnose complex problems.

This advanced program is an intense training and academic program provided by ATC in partnership with Toyota Motor North America, Inc. (TMNA), Southeast Toyota Distributors, local Toyota and Lexus dealers, and Broward College.

Students must enroll in Broward College within two (2) years of completing the program at Atlantic Technical College. Additional college credit may be awarded with the attainment of additional industry credentials.
