OPEN DOOR GRANTS

ATC students, there are two (2) grants available that provide up to \$3000 towards the cost of enrollment, including books & supplies:

Applicant Requirements:

1. Must choose an eligible program from list below and attend full time
2. Must be a US Citizen or eligible non-Citizen
3. Must attest to status of unemployed, underemployed, or furloughed
4. Must complete program orientation
5. Must complete online application including proof of Florida Residency
6. Must complete electronic grant application
7. For Student Investment Grant – must complete Student Attestation Form
8. Completion of FAFSA is strongly encouraged to determine unmet need for Last Dollar

Last Dollar

Submit your FAFSA and follow up with financial aid prior to applying for the grant to determine unmet need. You cannot be double funded (i.e. have the grant pay for the cost of enrollment and receive a Pell Grant beyond the cost of enrollment)

- a. Open to students who are eligible for federal and/or state aid who have unmet need as indicated by examples below:
 - i. Pell, Bright Futures
 - ii. Perkins voucher for industry exam given to you by the school official
 - iii. Voucher from Vocational Rehabilitation, CareerSource Broward

Student Investment

- a. Open to any self-paying student
- b. Student pays first 1/3 of the cost of enrollment, balance of remaining 2/3 is deferred to the grant
- c. If a student drops the program, is withdrawn, does not successfully complete their program, or does not pass the program industry credential, they will owe an additional 1/3 of the cost of enrollment back to the school and will be placed in default
