

# ELECTROCARDIOGRAPH TECHNOLOGY

### Course Content:

The program trains students to become EKG/cardiovascular technicians who can work in a variety of healthcare facilities including hospitals, nursing homes, clinics and physician offices. Students will learn how to perform a 12 lead EKG, properly maintain diagnostic equipment, recognize normal and abnormal sinus rhythms and monitor patients for cardiovascular disorders.

An overview of anatomy and physiology, with emphasis on cardiac and vascular systems is taught along with medical terminology, basic patient care techniques, medical instrumentation, cardiac monitoring and testing, and cardiac wellness and rehabilitation. A clinical experience is offered along with classroom simulation of various technical procedures and hands on practice.
