# PATIENT CARE **TECHNICIAN**

### COURSE CONTENT

This program prepares the student to function as a multi-skilled healthcare worker who, under the direction and supervision of a registered nurse, carries out the essential basic bedside patient care functions. The Patient Care Technician comes in direct contact with the patient in the performance of his/her assigned duties. Students also receive supplementary training in 12-lead EKG, basic phlebotomy techniques and restorative skills.

Upon successful completion of the program, students will have the opportunity to take the Certified Patient Care Technician/Assistant or ertified Nursing Assistant examination given by the Florida Board of Nursing. This is an excellent course for students who have no previous medical experience and who wish to enter the healthcare field.
