They epitomize the "earn while you learn" philosophy, providing apprentices with an income while they acquire specialized skills through a combination of on-the-job training and classroom instruction. Atlantic Technical College offers apprenticeship opportunities in a wide array of fields such as Carpentry, Electrical, Glazers, Heating and Air-Conditioning Mechanic and Installer, Industrial Pipefitter (Sprinkler Fitter), Line Erector, Machining, Operating Engineers, Painting and Decoration, Plumbing, Roofing, Structural Steel (Ironworker), and Yacht Service Technician, in collaboration with our sponsors. Apprenticeship students will experience all facets of each trade including planning, management, finance, production skills, underlying principles of technology, labor issues, community issues and health, safety, and environmental issues.

ADDITIONAL SKILLS COVERED:

Each program will train each apprentice with the specific skills and knowledge needed to become a journeyman and/or skilled tradesperson in the chosen field and may include:

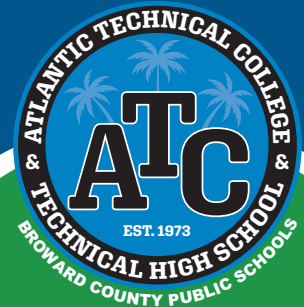
