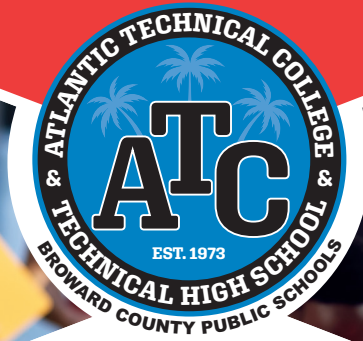


2026-2027 ADULT EDUCATION GED® UNDERAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students aged 16 and older who withdraw from school can take the GED® Test without completing the GED® Ready practice tests, but candidates under 18 must obtain FLDOE approval by submitting proof of withdrawal and an underage testing form.

GUIDELINES:

FOR UNDERAGE PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS PLANNING TO ENROLL IN A GED® PREPARATION COURSE:

STEP 1

- Students must be 16 or 17 years old
- Create a GED® account [GED.com](https://www.ged.com)
- The parent or legal guardian of the individual sixteen (16) and seventeen (17) years of age must:
 - complete, sign, and notarize the **“NEW” Florida Underage Testing Form**
 - obtain proof of withdrawal from high school
 - submit BOTH documents to the **High School Equivalency Diploma Program** office via email at GEDAgeWaiver@fldoe.org or by fax to 850.245.0449
