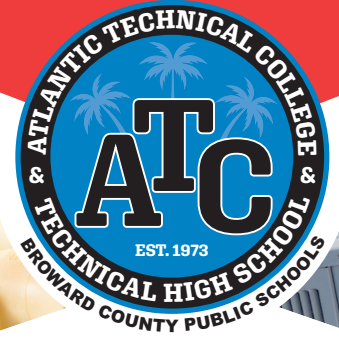

Atlantic Technical College offers apprenticeship opportunities in a wide array of fields such as Carpentry, Electrical, Glaziers, Heating and Air-Conditioning Mechanic and Installer, Industrial Pipefitter (Sprinkler Fitter), Line Erector, Machining, Operating Engineers, Painting and Decoration, Plumbing, Roofing, Structural Steel (Ironworker), and Yacht Service Technician, in collaboration with our sponsors. Apprenticeship students will experience all facets of each trade including planning, management, finance, production skills, underlying principles of technology, labor issues, community issues and health, safety, and environmental issues.
