COURSE

Patient Care Assistant is an integrated education and training program for students interested in rapidly earning the credentials and skills necessary to enter the healthcare field while simultaneously continuing to learn English. Through an integrated approach and single set of learning objectives, student will complete an ESOL, GED®, ABE program and cross-train as nursing assistants in preparation for employment. The program provides foundational knowledge, skills, and training in communication, interpersonal skills, infection control, safety and emergency procedures, promotion of residents' independence, and respecting patients' rights.
