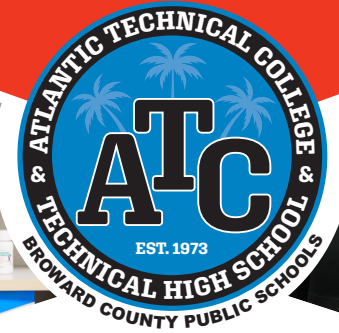

COURSE

Pharmacy Technicians generally work under the supervision of a registered Pharmacist and perform tasks related to receiving, dispensing, distribution, control, maintenance, compounding, manufacturing, packaging, and labeling of pharmaceutical products. Currently, Pharmacy Technicians are assigned responsibility for routine tasks, previously performed by pharmacists, and are responsible for mastering new pharmacy technology as it becomes available. Opportunities for advancement may vary with the pharmacy technician's employer. Upon successful completion of this program, students will earn an Applied Technology Diploma (ATD).
